SHELBY COUNTY			Preparation stipend of \$25/hour for up to 50 hours of prep time outside the regular school day/hours; \$1,500 salary supplement (in addition to the state's supplement) upon certification.
OLDHAM COUNTY	Pay half the certification fee		An annual \$2,500 salary supplement for the life of the certificate. NBCTs that mentor cohort groups of candidates are eligible to receive \$500 per person in that group (max. of 5 teachers) an additional \$500 for any who achieve certification.
