| BAYFIELD | | | NBCTs shall be placed on Lane 8 of the Salary Schedule |
| GREEN BAY | | | \$2,500 upon attaining National Board Certification and \$2,500 per year during the term of the certification (10 years) |
| KIEL | | | NBCTs will move to the MA level if they are at the BA-BA+24 level; and the MA+18 level if they are at the MA-MA+12 level. |
| KOHLER | | | An annual stipend a stipend in the same amount as that provided by the State of Wisconsin for NBCTs for the life of the certificate (Approximately \$2400 as of October 1, 2001 .) By June 30 of the current school year the teacher must notify the District Administrator they will be actively certified for the ensuing school year. Proof of certification must be presented by August 15 in order to receive the stipend. The stipend will be paid in a lump sum no later than September 30 . |

| MANITOWOC | | | 13% increase in compensation for the life of the certificate according to the Overlay Compensation System |
| MARSHFIELD: | 100% of the application fee paid by the district: 50% be upon application and 50% to be paid upon completion. | | An annual additional compensation of 2% of salary |
| MELLEN | | | Effective July 1, 2004 , NBCTs shall receive an additional educational lane change from their normal placement based on credits and degrees. If proof of certification is turned in to the District Office by March 31st , the salary adjustment shall be effective retro-active to the beginning of the school year. |
| MUKWONAGO | | | A \$1000 annual stipend for as long as they are certified |
| SHIOCTON | | | NBCTs will be moved into the BA/BS or MA/MS Master Educator lanes |
| SHOREWOOD | | | Reimbursement for further educational opportunities and professional not to exceed \$1,000.00. Bargaining unit NBCTs and Ph. D.s will be granted an annual stipend of \$1 000.00 for <i>either</i> the certification <i>or</i> the Ph. D., in addition to their salary as long as they retain certification |

| VERONA | | One day of paid leave to prepare for portfolio or assessment | |
| WEST DE PERE | | | National Board Certification is equivalent to having earned the district's professional development certificate for compensation purposes |
