

2011 NBPTS Conference Scoring Criteria for Presentation Proposals

Sessions will be chosen based on several factors. The proposal must demonstrate high quality outcomes, alignment to strand, relevance to NBCTs, design and delivery, impact, and presenter expertise. Other considerations will be number of proposals submitted per strand, attendee interest and scheduling needs.

High quality proposals clearly, consistently, and convincingly demonstrate:

- The knowledge and skills participants will gain as a result of the session
- The alignment with the strand and topic(s).
- The relevance to NBCTs and/or NBPTS stakeholders
- The connectivity of the outcomes with the delivery
- The interactivity between presenter and participants
- The contribution to the field and/or innovative practice
- The expertise and experience of the presenter on the topic
