

USING THE TEACHER INCENTIVE ALLOTMENT TO GROW NATIONAL BOARD CERTIFIED TEACHERS

WHAT IS NATIONAL BOARD CERTIFICATION?

- A voluntary advanced professional certification that identifies teaching expertise through a performance-based, peer-reviewed assessment
- Designed to collect standards-based evidence of accomplished practice

WHAT IS REQUIRED TO BECOME BOARD CERTIFIED?

- Eligible candidates must demonstrate advanced knowledge, skills, and practice in their individual certificate area
- 4 components - one computer-based and three portfolio-based

WHAT IS THE TEACHER INCENTIVE ALLOTMENT (TIA)?

- An initiative to recognize highly effective teachers and incentivize them to teach at the highest needs campuses
- Funding can be used to support teachers who wish to pursue National Board Certification

HOW DOES THE TEACHER INCENTIVE ALLOTMENT BENEFIT DISTRICTS?

- Research shows National Board certified teachers have greater impact on student learning
- NBCTs with a recognized designation will generate between \$3-\$9k for their district

HOW CAN DISTRICTS SUPPORT THE NATIONAL BOARD PROCESS?

- Form cohorts of National Board candidates and offer support throughout the year
- Match candidates to an NBCT mentor
- Request reimbursement from TIA to cover certification fees
